History

Our Club was founded in 1917 as the first small town Rotary Club in the United States. Today, the New Phila Rotary includes about 32 members.

Meetings

The Tuscora Park Connection

...Tuscora Park is Rotary's best-known service project. RTY, Inc. is a not-for-profit corporation responsible for the Tuscora Park Rides, Concessions, Amphitheater, and Park Place Teen Center. New Phila Rotarians comprise the RTY Board of Directors and work closely with the City's Park staff to operate and maintain these community assets.
...Club members provide "hands on" service to the Park, working in May to do cleanup, spread mulch and plant flowers.

Fundraising

...The Rotary Spring Healthcheck is the Club's largest fundraising event.
...Rotary solicits donations for the maintenance and display of Storybook Lane each Christmas Season.
...The "Salute Freedom" American Flag Project generates funds earmarked by the Club for student scholarships.

Eligibility

People of all ages in all professional or management positions, living or working in New Philadelphia or the surrounding areas may be considered for membership. All membership applications are subject to Board approval.

Obligations of Members

Members are expected to attend a minimum of 60% of club meetings per year. You can "make up" a missed meeting at any other Rotary Club. Members are expected to actively participate in projects and committees, become project leaders, and eventually consider service as a club officer.

Cost of Membership

Rotary dues are \$75 per year. A \$10 meal charge is assessed even if the member does not attend the meeting. Annual charges for Rotary Club membership will total about \$600. Invoices are sent out quarterly.
